Stipends and position allocation review and recommendations	 Annual recommendations to the Sponsoring Institution's administration regarding resident/fellow stipends and benefits Guest Presenter: Namil Choi – UND SMHS Associate Dean for Admin & Finance/COO (See Attachment 3) – Mr. Choi presented Administration and Finance proposal of stipends and benefits for UNDSMHS residents and fellows. Mr. Choi presented spreadsheets comparing UND Stipends Central Region of the United States. He also showed a comparison with one of UND's peer institutions, South Dakota. Mr. Choi also review a possible new benefit to residents/fellows whereas residents/fellows who choose to go out in the market and purchase dental insurance, the university would provide a lump sum payment (taxable) to help defray the cost of a dental 	A "motion was made to approve all benefits as presented." insurance plan of the resident/fellow choosing. Resident/fellow would be required to proof of enrollment in a plan to receive the stipend.

Discussions on Stipends:

- Clarification of calculated rates and comparisons
- Program administration concerns of median rate and discussion that because of the climate, a higher stipend would help with recruitment and quality of recruitment.
- We need to be higher than the median for recruitment.
- Ahmeti questions re: decreasing the raise trajectory?
 - Namil Want to be consistent with staff/faculty and resident increases. Mr. Choi then discussed using the proposed FY25 rate but reserved the right to manually adjust the rate to consider improving that rate if it isn't similar to market benchmarks.
- Ahmeti want to improve recruitment opportunities but if we are comparing regional pay scales, we need to be above the benchmark to improve the quality of candidates we want to recruit. It would be hard to compete with places such as Minneapolis if we are offering the same pay scale.
- Johnson We need to be higher than average to compete. Above the median to compete.
- Lou- Having trouble getting candidates to North Dakota. We need to look at 60,65, 75 percentage marks.
- Dr. Becker said we can suggest any recommendation to SMHS finance, and they will make the final decision based on available finance.

Discussions on Dental stipend:

- The majority of the committee indicated in the chat support of a dental benefit prior to a motion being made.
- Mr. Choi said the home department would be responsible for Add Pay request after receiving documented payment of insurance premium.
- Dr. Raum encouraged the residents to speak up since this would be a benefit to the residents.
- Dr. Townsend asked for clarification of the benefit.
- Mr. Choi clarified that the resident would need to go purchase whatever plan they chose, and a certain dollar

	 amount would be reimbursed to the resident with a copy of the paid receipt. Residents may choose not to get a dental plan and no reimbursement would be received. Discussion of receiving the stipend without the plan to use the dollars for preventative care. Mr. Choi said there are compliance issues with that.
